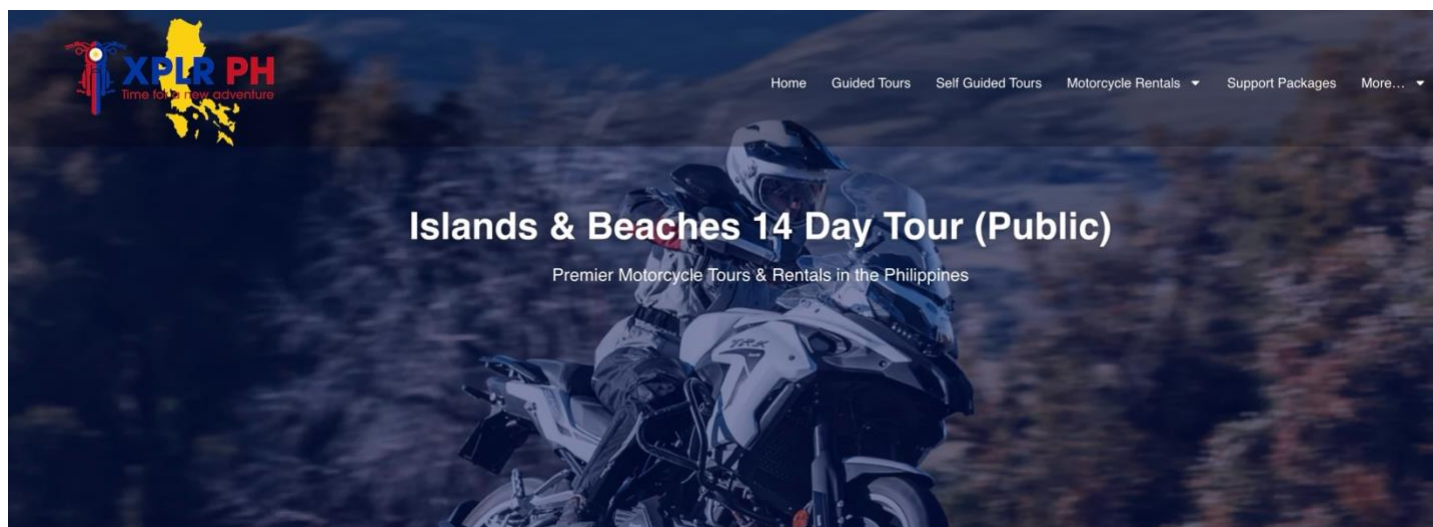




Islands & Beaches 14 Day Tour (Public)

14 Days, 14 Nights

11 days riding (incl orientation) & 3 rest days

Distance: ~1,700 km / 1,055 miles

Embark on the island hopping bike tour of a lifetime. 1,700km, 5 islands and 8 ferry crossings. But the numbers don't tell the whole story. This tour combines thrilling coastal roads, with world class beaches, historical and cultural experiences, first class accommodation and much more.

Visit the world famous white-sand beaches of Boracay, Puerto Galera and Guimaras; ride the twisties of Mindoro, and the loops of Panay and Guimaras.

Take in the grandeur of the Taal Basilica (officially the *Minor Basilica of Saint Martin of Tours*), often considered the most impressive and largest Catholic church in the Philippines (and sometimes in Asia). Also the Miagao Church a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the Simbahang Bato a semi ruin of a Spanish Colonial church still in use today. Especially for the Led Zeppelin fans out there, we will visit the "Stairway to Heaven" at Garin Farm, Panay.

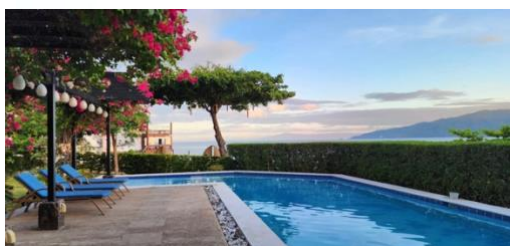
Snapshot

From your Tagaytay accommodation we ride along the ridge of the volcanic caldera for a sumptuous breakfast overlooking Taal volcano lake. From here we will



leave the province of Cavite and ride into Batangas province through the longest tunnel

in the Philippines and then down the coast and east to visit the Taal Basilica for lunch.



After lunch continue east to Mabini a coastal municipality famous for extremely rich marine biodiversity and best known as the gateway to Anilao, one of the Philippines' most famous scuba diving destinations .

We take the ferry over to Mindoro and head north through the province of Mindoro Oriental, along fast twisty roads towards Puerto Galera, one of the Philippines' best-known beach and diving destinations. We stay here for two nights to enjoy the beaches & nightlife.



Next we track south, stopping at Simbahang Bato one of the most historic and unusual churches in Oriental Mindoro then to our overnight accommodation in Roxas.

The next day starts with a short blast down the coast to catch the ferry over to the island of Panay, and to our overnight accommodation in the province of Aklan.

A scenic ride down the west coast of Panay, traveling through the province of Antique, over the highlands into Iloilo province. We will visit the World Heritage Miagao Church as we ride along the coast to our overnight accommodation in Iloilo City.



The next morning we take a short ferry ride over to the island of Guimaras. Once there we complete the Guimaras Loop, stopping for some lunch along the way.



A rest day in Guimaras for you to go Island hopping , visit the Mango Research Centre , the Trappist Monastery or Guisi Lighthouse, or just lay by the pool.



Next morning we take a short ride back to the ferry port to catch the RORO over to Iloilo on the island of Panay. We ride to the very north east of the island to our accommodation in Carles, a laid-back fishing-town, with seafood, beaches, mangroves, and boat ports serving travelers heading to the islands.



Next we ride west along the top of Panay, through the province of Capiz and back into Aklan. At Caticlan we will leave the bikes in secured parking and take the short ferry ride across to Boracay (bikes not allowed).

Boracay is one of the Philippines' most famous beach destinations, known worldwide for its powdery white sand, turquoise water, sunsets, nightlife, and water activities. We enjoy two nights here to soak up the vibe.

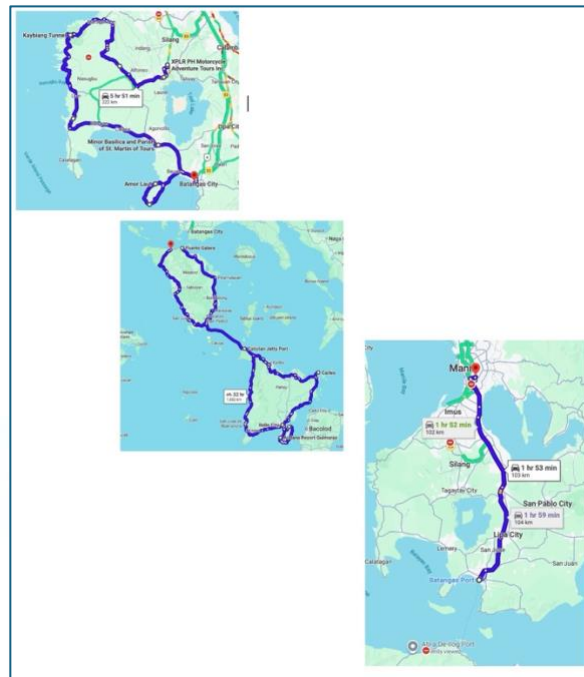


A short ferry ride back to Caticlan to be reunited with our bikes, then a longer ferry ride back to Mindoro to continue our Mindoro Loop. Heading west to our overnight accommodation on the water at San Jose, in the province of Mindoro Occidental.

Heading home we ride up the west coast of Mindoro; the road is smooth, fast, twisty in places and very scenic, to catch the ferry back to Batangas, Luzon. From Batangas we take the expressway straight into the heart of Manila where we will drop off the bikes, pick up any excess luggage and head to our final night's accommodation. After checking-in to our city accommodation we will partake in a few well-earned cold beers at Handlebar Bar & Grill, the famous biker's hangout in Makati.
