From the scenic Taal volcano, you travel northeast to Baler, the capital of Aurora Province and birthplace of surfing in the Philippines.



On through the Sierra Madre Mountain range, home to the Aeta people, one of the oldest indigenous groups and onwards to Sagada.

Here you will have a rest day to allow you to explore the Banaue Rice Terraces, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, or the world-famous Hanging Coffins, or visit Apo Whang-Od, the country's most renowned traditional tattoo artist (mambabatok), born in 1917 and still practicing into her 100s, or any of the other local attractions and activities.



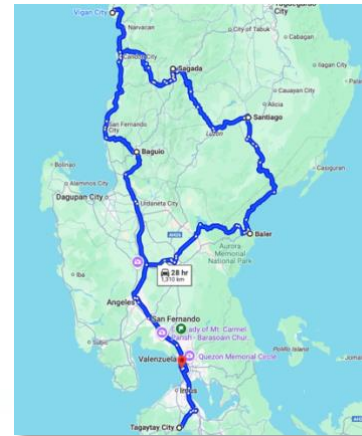
Then on to the UNESCO World Heritage city of Vigan and another rest day.

A coastal ride south, hugging pristine shores and back into the mountains to visit Baguio, the Summer Capital of the Philippines, so called because of its cool climate, pine-covered hills, vibrant arts scene and rich colonial history. Now back to Manila for a few well-earned cold beers at the famous Handlebar Bar & Grill.
